

# STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in Village of Malone, NY effective at  
(area within municipality, or entire municipality)

12:00 am on February 12, 2013.

This State of Emergency has been declared due to the professionally documented hazard of  
a large, stone building collapsing onto our Main Street (NYS Highway 11) and into the  
Salmon River, where the 20' (description of situation) deep pile of rubble will obliterate the  
Village's main sewer line, through which 1.2 million gallons of raw sewage pours, daily.  
*This situation threatens the public safety.*

*This State of Emergency will remain in effect until rescinded by a subsequent order.*
